

Audit Requirements

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Would anyone receiving a grant be required to submit audit information?

2 CFR Part 200 requires local governments that receive a significant amount of federal grant assistance (including loans) to have an annual audit.

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2. Do you have the forms we will need to fill out for this Audit?

Yes, you will be required to submit an Audit Information Form to the Kansas Department of Commerce each fiscal year.

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3. Where can the Audit Information Form be found?

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4. When is this Audit Information Form due?

This form is due to the Department of Commerce on or before May 15th of each fiscal year.

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5. Are Audits reviewed by the Department?

Audits are reviewed by the Department to ensure that federal audit requirements are being met as well as to handle findings of noncompliance or questioned costs relating to the CDBG projects.
