

Community Facilities Frequently Asked Questions

1. What does this program do?

The Community Development Block Grant program (CDBG) provides funds that assist communities in financing community facilities projects.

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2. What do Community Facilities projects include?

Projects include, but are not limited to, fire protection, bridges, community and senior centers, demolition, drainage, ambulances, streets, architectural barrier removal, etc.

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3. How often are these funds allocated?

Funds are allocated to small cities on an annual basis, usually in the fall of each year.

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4. What is the minimum allowed for each grant?

Minimum allowed is \$2,000 per beneficiary.

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5. What is required of the community?

An application must be submitted stating the community's needs, proposed solution and all associated costs.

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6. What happens after the grant has been awarded?

Proceed with designing your project and during the construction phase a CDBG specialist will conduct two monitorings.

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7. When can the project be closed?

The project can be closed when all construction is done, and the resolution of all potential monitoring findings is complete.
