

# Water and Sewer Facilities Frequently Asked Questions

1. What does this program do?

The Community Development Block Grant program (CDBG) funds projects that assist communities in financing water and sewer infrastructure projects.

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2. How often are these funds allocated?

These funds are allocated on an annual basis, usually in the fall of each year.

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3. What is the minimum allowed for each grant?

Minimum allowed is \$2,000 per beneficiary.

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4. What types of upgrades fall under this program?

Water and sewer upgrades include: water/sewer lines, plants, lagoons, lift stations, water towers, etc.

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5. What is required of the community?

An application must be submitted stating the community's needs, proposed solution and all associated costs.

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6. What happens after the grant has been awarded?

Proceed with designing your project and during the construction phase, CDBG field representatives will conduct two monitorings.

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7. When can the project be closed?

The project can be closed when all construction is done, and the resolution of all potential monitoring findings is complete.
