Thin gauge stainless steel, sheet metal experience is required in order to become a Modine-Joplin welder. This is not pipe welding; this is not heavy gauge structural steel welding. This does not require any kind of code or ASME or AWS certification. This is not pressure vessel or boiler welding. It is more like artwork or making jewelry – it is a highly-skilled person that can do this type of welding. You need to be able to TIG weld thin-gauge stainless steel as well as MIG weld thin-gauge stainless steel. The successful candidate, in the past, may have done work like fabricating exhaust hoods, fabricating truck tool boxes, or welding that requires the highest level of cosmetic (good) appearance. Recent experience (like in the last six months) will probably give you an advantage over others at passing the Modine welding test
