We concur with IdeaTek's statements in support of our application to serve rural Pratt County and Preston. Further, IdeaTek acknowledges and SCTelcom concurs the CERG Grant Project #54 does overlap a 'significant' portion of SCTelcom's proposed service area, yet fixed wireless service is not capable of addressing the longterm needs and demands of the consumers therein.
