ABOUT THE NEED

Fixed wireless connectivity is a critical challenge for citizens in Wilson County. With assistance from the Broadband Acceleration Grant, KwiKom plans to bring broadband expansion to 829 households, 42 businesses, three educational institutions, three municipal organizations as well as two healthcare organizations in the Wilson County communities of Thayer, Fredonia and Altoona. KwiKom will construct a reliable state-of-the-art gigabit fiber to the home and business network in these communities – bringing reliable broadband access to these communities

where fixed wireless is not an option. KwiKom has recognized through the recent events how important broadband is to these communities for education, work, and healthcare as well as where it lacks today. Feedback from these communities has shown that their only options are insufficient and very unreliable. KwiKom is committed to expanding broadband to offer connectivity to Wilson and Neosho County.
