

KANSAS INTERAGENCY ADVISORY COMMITTEE (KIAC) MEETING DATES FOR 2021

The KIAC meets in Topeka on the second and fourth Tuesday of each month from May through July. We have one meeting available on August 10th and an additional early meeting of an April 27th. All KIAC meetings will be held virtually this year and we will not have a reserved date for Western Kansas as was done in the past. All applicants may schedule for any date regardless of location.

The Dates for the 2022 KIAC appointments are as follows:

April- 27th
May- 11th and 25th
June- 8th and 22nd
July-13th and 27th
August- 10th

Each appointment is scheduled for one hour. Communities are strongly encouraged to meet early in their application process to assure they are on the right track and address any issues that may arise during their meeting discussions. Appointments at the end of the KIAC schedule fill up quickly and we have had to turn away communities due to lack of spots.

To set an appointment with the committee, a two-page signed KIAC Profile must be submitted with preliminary engineering report estimates completed to date by the 1st or 15th of the month prior to the next meeting date. The community will then be invited to attend the next available meeting. The number of community participants is not limited; however, at least one official member of the entity and the engineer must be present at the meeting. The KIAC is good for two consecutive calendar years (e.g. if you attend in May 2021, it's good for the 2022 and 2023 program).
