**Art's:**

Ballet Folklórico de Topeka, is Justicia's oldest ongoing arts program. Since 1976, the ballet has worked to promote cultural dance in the Topeka community and the state of Kansas. Members of the Ballet work on leadership skills and give back to their community by tutoring elementary students at local schools. The Ballet is affiliated with Asociacion Nacional de Grupo Folkloricos, an international organization that promotes and preserves the Mexican folklore culture.



**EDUCATION:**

Justicia's mission to promote education in the Latin community began in the 1990's with English as a second language classes. Today we continue to offer educational programs and forums addressing social issues impacting the Latin community. In response to our community's needs, we are focusing our resources on providing tutoring educational panels and keeping the community updated to changes in immigration practices. Work is in progress to provide Citizenship classes by this fall.

**GALERIA DE ARTE / (Community Center)**

Located in the NOTO Arts District, Justicia's community center serves as the location for traditional latin celebrations including El Dia de Los Muertos (All Saint's Day), Cinco de Mayo, art galleries, dance workshops, classroom for educational classes, and studio also available for private events.
