**Public Comments For Areas Where Service Already Exists:**  
**Nex-Tech is currently serving residential customers with up to Gig symmetrical (1000 Mbps x 1000Mbps) fiber connections that are shown in AMG's application near Salina. Nex-Tech has built the area along south Ohio and north of Water Well Road with fiber optic cable and has been offering service in this area for almost two years. This area should not be considered for grant funding due to already being served.**

**Nex-Tech started deploying a fiber-to-the-premise infrastructure in the city of Salina, Kansas in 2016 and today has fiber routes throughout most of the business corridors and some residential areas within and near the city. Please see the attached proprietary documentation which shows a fiber route that covers the area of south Ohio and north of Water Well Road. Nex-Tech can provide up to Gigabit symmetrical speeds (1000 Mbps x 1000 Mbps) for all locations that are served with fiber. Speed tests from customer locations are included which show that the customers who are subscribing to 200 Mbps symmetrical plans are receiving over 200 Mbps symmetrical speeds.**
