Myself, to ensure a decent internet connection I have to make sure I can tether to my laptop to my phone. A reliable internet connection is vital to my ability to work from home.

As a local landlord and owner of a 16-unit apartment complex, I am familiar with several remote workers and students that have come to town permanently and temporarily. They have been highly dependent on being connected to the internet and can not afford to have slow speed times, during peak hours, keeping them from doing their job or studying. As a community leader, pharmacist, and landlord looking for the next way to help our community grow, I notice more and more people leaving urban areas to look for a rural community to raise children. They may be remote workers, their children may be homeschooled, or they may be retired. Our aging population is more connected than ever before and this will only continue to grow. We need a reliable form of internet that can handle, not only our current bandwidth, but any bandwidth growth we may see in decades to come. We need to be able to market our community as capable of supporting these people. This includes not only the town of Oberlin, but the rural area surrounding it as many do not have access to reliable internet. More and more properties outside the city limits have been emptied over the years. In part, this is can be due to not having reliable infrastructural needs including internet. Marketing our entire community as a remote worker destination, while helping existing citizens and businesses succeed is vital to our sustainability.
