H&B has failed to satisfy the state's requirement that evidence must include information beyond FCC data for an area to be considered served, since H&B has not substantiated their assertion with any documentation (e.g., speed tests indicating that the claimed speeds, are, in fact, available). H&B Cable Service's contest only includes a verbal assertion that they serve the area with the sole link provided to prove their claims leading to 404 error.**
