Cox’s public challenge to Brightspeed Labette regards a planned future build that has yet to begin construction. Without concrete evidence (e.g., signed contracts for material procurement and labor agreements with construction crews), Cox has failed to satisfy the burden of proof laid upon them, particularly given the prevailing shortages in the supply chain and of skilled labor that must be mitigated. In contrast, we have provided evidence of our contracts in place and additional preparations underway in our application to prove our timeline fits the state’s requirement.
