**In our area broadband is not available (south of K32 from the LV/WYCO line and to the west). We were told years ago that the AT&T lines were so old and would be updated and with the update broadband service would be available. Never happened. The only internet service we could get was slow satellite service which didn't have enough speed to work from home or stream tv and was very expensive for limited plans. We tried an AT&T hotspot but it was very expensive for unlimited and couldn't handle our needs with kids doing online school and working from home. Nexus air fiber came to the area and offers faster speeds and no caps but it is unreliable and not available to many residents. You can only get it if you have visible sight to the tower. We have visible sight but lose service during storms, on a sunny day, if it too hot, too cloudy...you get my point. We work from home and it goes down multiple times a week and usually during an important presentation! In this post-covid environment and remote work being the norm for many, we need reliable internet service. We are NOT in a very rural area. We have rooftops that need service in this little area of southern LV county. We are 1 mile off K32, 1 mile from the LV/WYCO county line and 1 mile from LV county road 2. I'm not sure what kind of supporting documentation you need. Come out and check for yourself. Type in my address to various providers and it will say, "no service provided in your area." We have no broadband...period.**
