Please describe:	<p><b>Coffeyville received a challenge from AMG Technology stating that a portion of our proposed project is part of their RDOF program and therefore is considered served by federal standards.</b></p> <p><b>Coffeyville believes that, like other RDOF winners, census blocks were just grabbed up to help sell their service. For example, my home, which is in a proposed RDOF "served" census block that has no other infrastructure around it served by this winning bidder. Logically, it makes zero sense for them to build infrastructure to serve a whopping 8 homes in the middle of nowhere.</b></p> <p><b>Coffeyville has served the proposed area with wireless service since before 2007.</b></p> <p><b>The homes in that area are our friends and neighbors. We'd hate to see them not be included in the project because of an RDOF project that "might" happen in the next 5-8 years and miss out on an opportunity for high speed internet that can be installed in less than 1 year by our utility.</b></p>
Please provide your response to the public comments received in the text box below:	<p><b>Portions of the RDOF challenge made by AMG Technology have been served by the City of Coffeyville prior to 2007. The industrial park, which falls under the RDOF portion, has had fiber access since 2016 provided by the City of Coffeyville's internet utility.</b></p> <p><b>Coffeyville is in no way trying to duplicate efforts. We believe our project is better suited for homes in the proposed project area as these are our neighbors, our customers and our friends.</b></p> <p><b>Construction and deployment of our project would have fiber internet available to homes in the proposed project area within a year, not years like an RDOF project.</b></p>
