I live in rural Coffeyville where options for internet are limited. I have previously tried wireless but it required line of sight to tower and there are too many trees. Currently using satellite. It works okay, except in the rain or snow, but it is slow and expensive. I pay \$110/month for unlimited "high speed" which caps at 60 GB. After that the speed drops until the month is over. Additional data can be purchased 5 GB for \$9.99. I generally use all 60GB in 22-24 days and then on slow speed for rest of month. I live by myself, have never streamed a movie and tv isn't set up for streaming. I would like to get rid of satellite tv due to high cost; streaming isn't option. I would like to have my security system connected by WiFi rather than a phone line; not an option. I would like to continue online photography and sewing classes; can do some until data speed drops. It is hard to watch classes when there is continual buffering. It became evident when grandkids tried some online school classes at my house during pandemic the speed was not adequate. Just keeping microsoft office and photography software updated requires a large amount of data. With so many everyday services now requiring internet, access to high speed, reliable service is a must not a want. The city of Coffeyville has successfully operated an internet utility for years and needs to grow it to serve ALL of their electric customers. They are currently stringing fiber optic lines for the installation of smart meters. They need additional funding to be able to build out their fiber to reach all HOMES (plus a large number of small businesses) and not just the utility poles. Rural America Kansas is the best place to be, but we are becoming more and more left behind by the lack of reliable, affordable high speed internet.
