("WTC") provides this information to the Kansas Office of Broadband Development (KOBD) in response to the Cox Communications ("Cox") G8 Capital Projects Fund application in Jackson, Shawnee, and Wabaunsee counties. WTC currently provides symmetrical Gigabit broadband using Fiber-to-the-Premise (FTTP) technology to every home and business in Rossville, KS. Attached please find all addresses in our Rossville service area that also appear to be included in Cox's grant application.

WTC completed its FTTP build in Rossville in 2021. The 12/31/2021 FCC Form 477 data filed by WTC reflects the 1,000 Mbps down / 1,000 Mbps up service available for all census blocks in Rossville. Please see the attached supporting documentation, including speed tests, that verify our current service in Rossville.

Please accept this evidence as proof that WTC currently serves Rossville, KS with speeds of 1,000 Mbps down / 1,000 Mbps up, and consider this area and corresponding addresses ineligible for receiving a Capital Projects Fund grant.
