<p>Please provide your response to the public comments received in the text box below:</p>	<p><b>Nextlink suggests that its CAF II funded award areas should preclude portions of this grant application from being funded. However, as indicated in our associated challenge response, Nextlink does not offer 20mbps upload as evidenced by its own marketing and FCC filings.</b></p> <p><b>Nextlink also suggests that its recent RDOF award should preclude portions of this application from being funded. However, we are unaware of any delivery timeline commitment for this obligation that would meet the 18 month deployment requirement of the state for such a challenge. Further, we are unaware of any existing fully scaled wireless deployment that actually achieves the speed commitments made in Nextlink’s RDOF award. Nextlink’s fixed wireless deployments also do not appear to fit with the wireline / fiber goals of the state broadband office, furthermore it is indicated in the CPF guidance that services exceeding 100/20 must be delivered via “wireline” to render that area served.</b></p> <p><b>Ideatek also points to the significant community support and reference letters in our applications. We believe this support for Ideatek would not exist if Nextlink was providing service sufficient for the broadband priorities of the communities involved in the project.</b></p>
