Cable One Inc., d.b.a. Sparklight (“Sparklight”) provides qualifying broadband services to an extensive portion of the service area in Montgomery County, KS (Independence area) where KwiKom applied for funds under the Kansas Office of Broadband Development Capital Projects Fund grant program. See Sparklight-KwiKom project area map submitted herewith.

Per its publicly published rate card, Sparklight offers broadband services in this area at speeds ranging from 200 Mbps download/20 Mbps upload to 940 Mbps download/50 Mbps upload. See Sparklight-Rate Card – Independence, KS submitted herewith.

Pursuant to additional submitted information (KwiKom Montgomery Address List), Sparklight’s network facilities pass 5,642 serviceable locations in the challenged area where KwiKom seeks funding to construct. Broadband service at or exceeding 100 Mbps download/20 Mbps upload is available from Sparklight to all residential customers in this defined area. In fact, per the information submitted here, Sparklight already provides broadband service to 2,421 of these 5,642 locations, at the service speeds indicated in the submitted information.

Because by this submission Sparklight demonstrates that service at or exceeding 100 Mbps down/20 Mbps up is available from Sparklight to all residential locations in the challenged area, we respectfully request that the challenged portion of KwiKom’s proposed grant area be disqualified from further funding consideration.
