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### County Appraiser Office

Contact your County's Appraiser's Office to request data on properties in your community, including the following:

- Property Address
- Year Built
- Quality of Property
- Condition of Property
- Total Appraised Value

- The U.S. Census Bureau generates analyses on the worker inflow and outflow in your community. It estimates:
  - 1) how many workers are employed in your city but live outside the city
  - 2) how many workers are employed outside of your city but live inside your city
  - 3) how many workers are employed and live inside your city
- This source provides insight on how many workers could be living in your community but don't have the opportunity due to lack of housing, amenities, quality of schools, etc.

### Missouri Census Data Center, ACS Profiles, <https://mcdc.missouri.edu/applications/acs/profiles/>

- This source uses the American Community Survey estimates to provide easy-to-read reports on community data.
- Topics include: Demographic, Economic, Social, and Housing.
- More than one area can be selected to make it easy to compare a community to neighboring cities, its county, or the state.
- The data reports can be exported to Excel or PDF format.
- The tables provide additional information on the reliability of the data. The font of the data indicates the relative margins of error. The bold values are the most reliable (under 15% margin of error), regular values are in-between (15% - 35% margin of error), and light-colored values have the highest margin of error (35% +) making it the least reliable. The more rural, the higher the margin of error (and less reliable it is).

- Realtor.com provides local housing market reports for each community.
- Data includes:
  - Number of homes for sale
  - Range of home values for sale
  - Median listing home price
  - Median listing home price per square foot
  - Median days on market
  - Sale-to-list price ratios (seller vs. buyer market)
