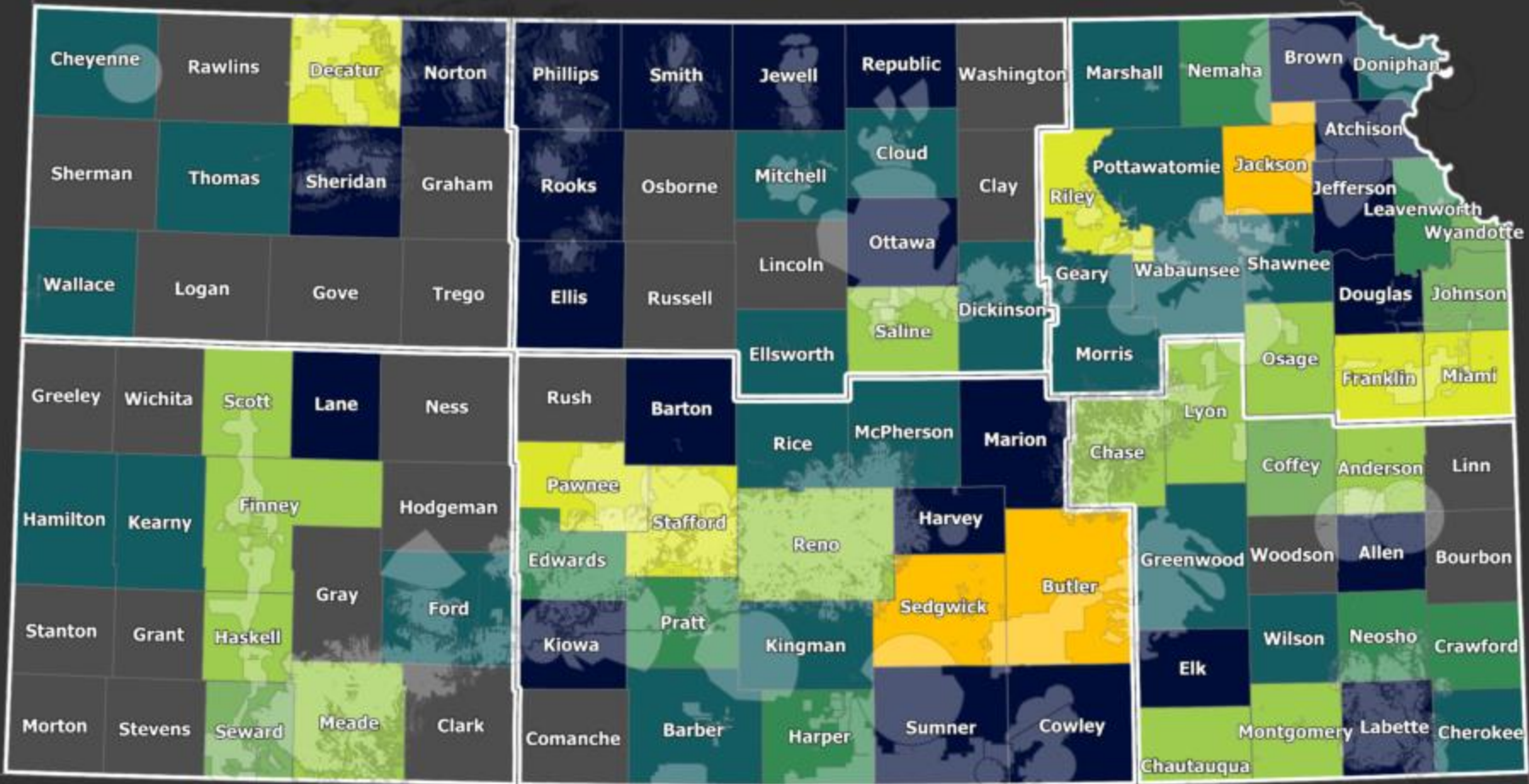

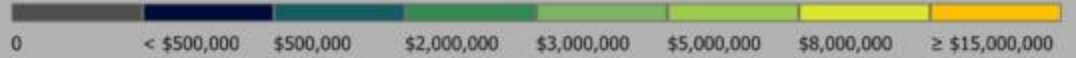

Broadband Development Investment (BPAG, CERG, BAG1.0, BAG2.0, CPF)

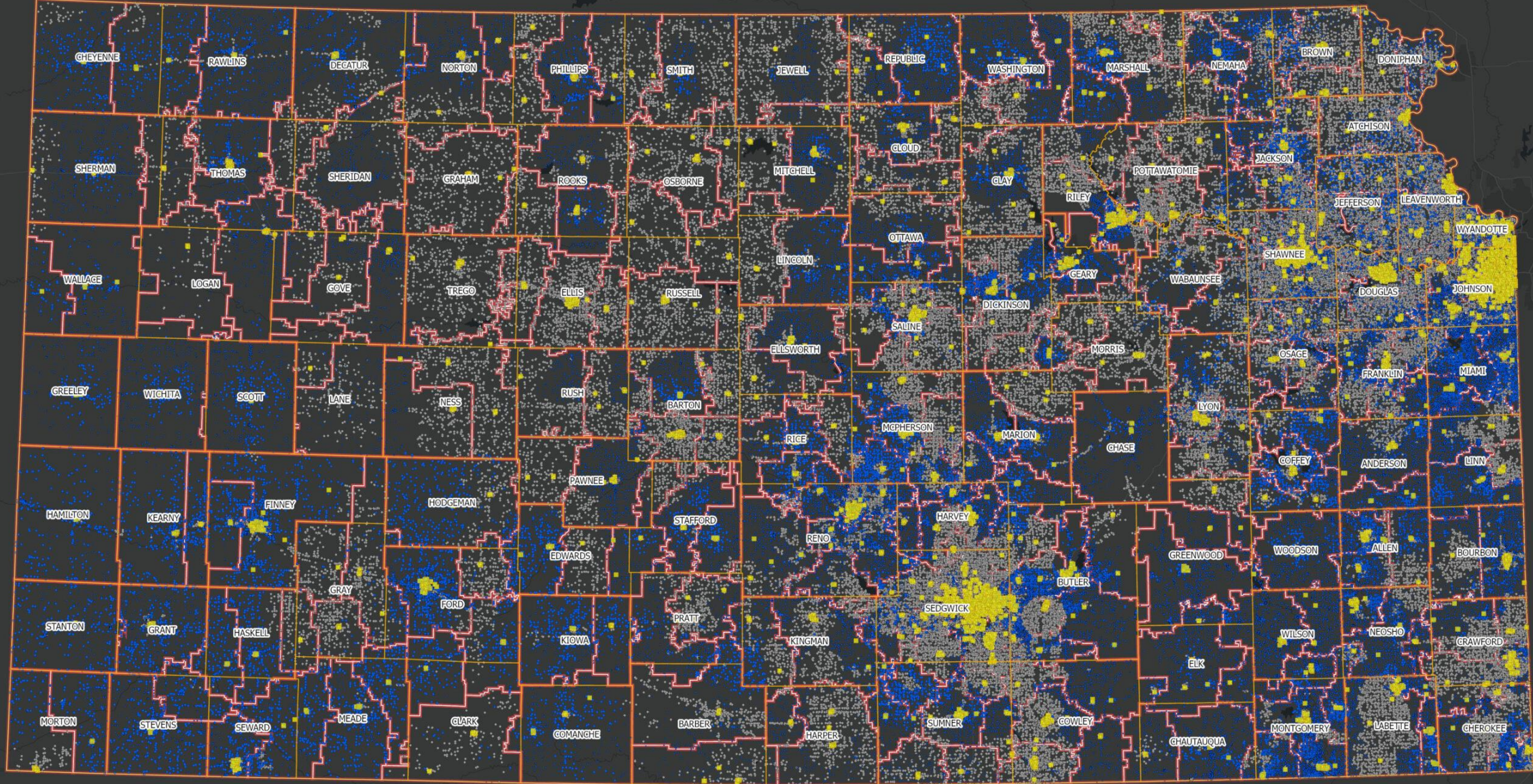


*Some broadband projects cover multiple counties, resulting in adjacent counties being shaded

Funding Opportunities-Round 2



Advancing Digital Opportunities to Promote Technology (ADOPT)

- Public Wi-fi CAI's*
 - Max award \$1 million
 - 10% Match
- Device Distribution
 - Max award \$500k
- Summer/Fall 2024
- \$4.4 million potentially available

CAI: Community Anchor Institution, i.e. Hospital, School, Library, Local Government Building



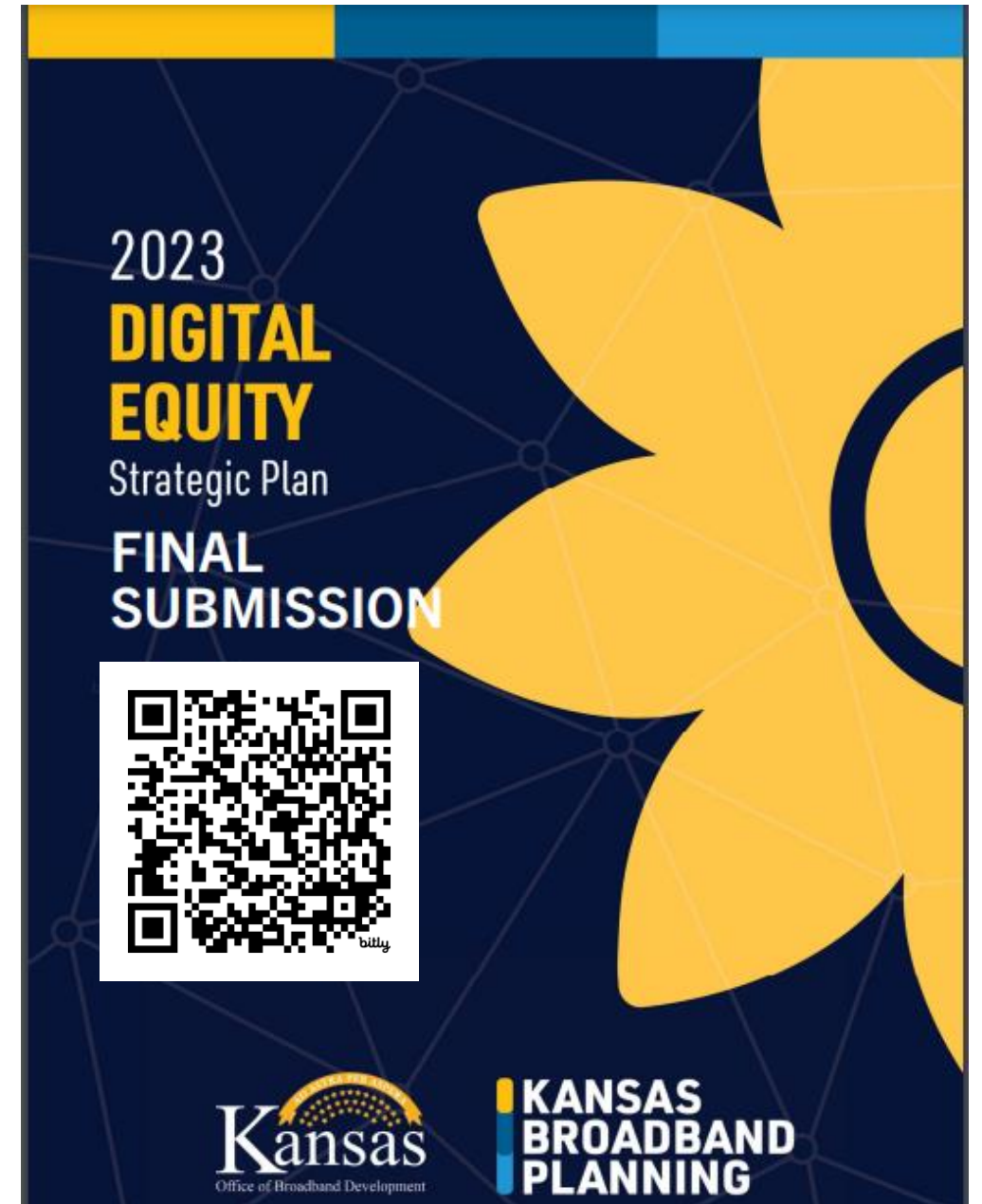
Digital Opportunities Connecting Kansans (DOCK)

- Digital Skills Training
- Focusing on the growth of digital skills, education, and knowledge
- Max award \$250k
- 5 % Match
- Summer/Fall 2024
- \$1.1 million potentially available



Funding Opportunities

- **Digital Equity Capacity Grants**
 - Allocated \$8.2 million
 - Complete Strategic Plan
 - Expect funding Fall 2024
 - Plan objectives
 - *Availability:* Improve availability of broadband across Kansas
 - *Affordability:* Increase access to and adoption of affordable broadband service
 - *Digital Literacy Skills:* Focus on the growth of digital literacy skills, education, and knowledge
 - *Cybersecurity:* Increase awareness of and proficiency in dealing with online privacy and cybersecurity issues
 - *Devices:* Expand access to affordable devices with accommodating technical support
 - *Public Services:* Promote the online accessibility and inclusivity of public resources and services

Funding Opportunities

State Program: Broadband Acceleration Grant

- \$85M over 10 years,
 - **\$5M 2020-2023**
 - **\$10M 2024-2030**
- Eligible areas lack 100/20 service
- 50/50 public private match
- January 2025

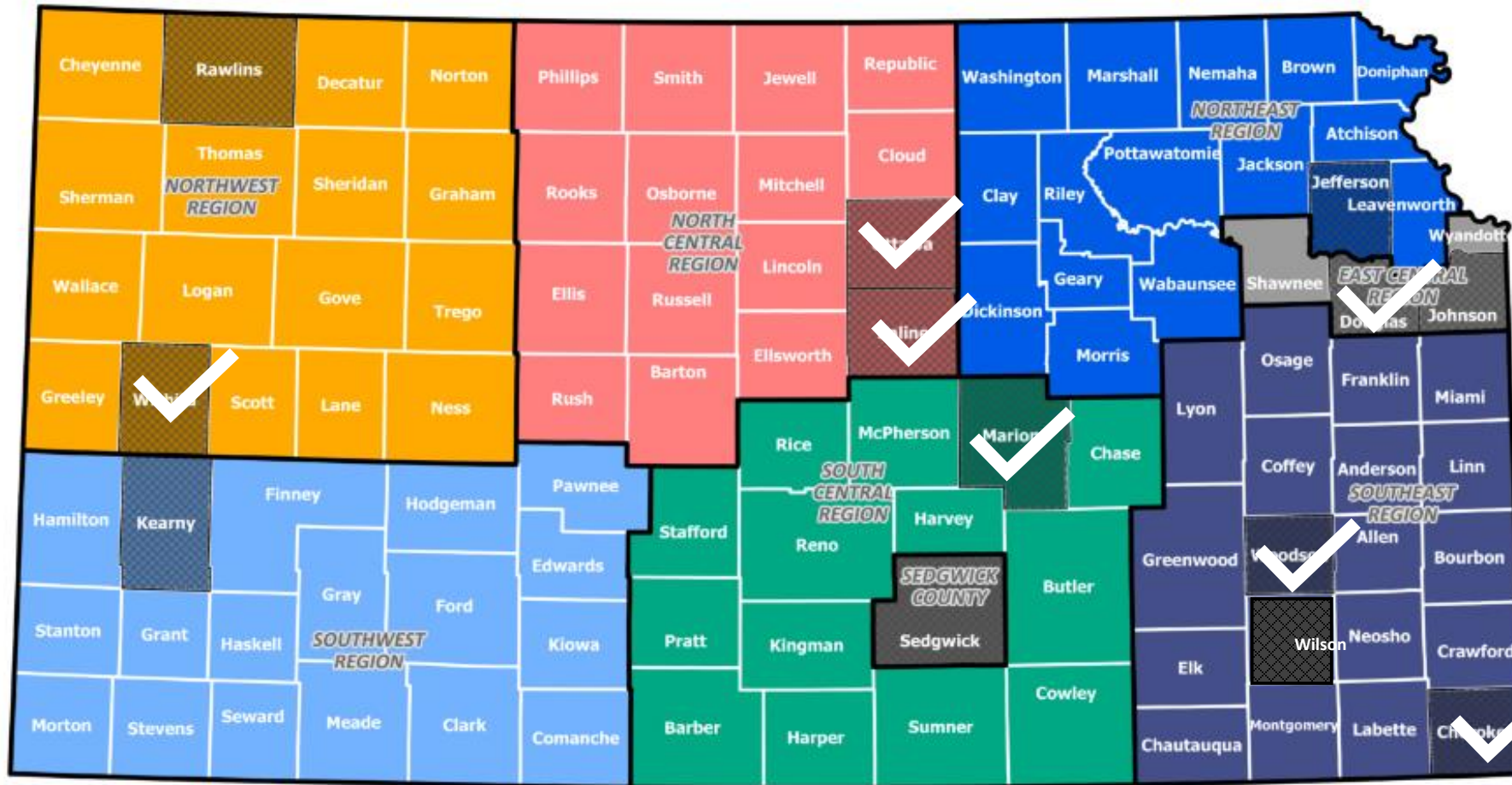
