Trego County-Lemke Memorial Hospital is a 25-bed critical access healthcare facility providing inpatient, emergency, and outpatient services.

Donations secured through the Community Service Program Tax Credits (CSP) will help fund renovations and improvements to the current facility to ensure state-of-the-art medical services and equipment and an expansion to include private inpatient rooms with accessible private bathrooms.



KIOWA DISTRICT HOSPITAL

Kiowa | Population 869

The Kiowa District Hospital is a 10-bed critical access healthcare facility providing inpatient, emergency, and outpatient services. They also offer childcare to their employees.

Donations secured through the Community Service Program Tax Credits (CSP) will help expand the Childcare School-Age Building to sixty children. The building will encompass a FEMA saferoom, mental wellness space, literacy corner, creative art area, and an adequate outdoor playground for physical activity.
