National Health Service Corps (NHSC) and Nurse Corps Programs



National Health Service Corps (NHSC)

- Provides scholarships and loan repayment to primary care medical, dental, and behavioral health providers in NHSC-eligible disciplines.
- NHSC providers, in turn, commit to serving at an NHSC-approved site located in a Health Professional Shortage Area.

Nurse Corps

- Loan repayment and scholarship program



FORHP Efforts to Address Health Care Issues in Rural America




