

Project Summary

The Southeast Kansas Impact Center for Wellness, Education is a new 11,000 sq. ft. multi-use facility adjacent to Neosho Memorial Regional Medical Center (NMRMC) in Chanute, KS. The project replaced a long-abandoned tuberculosis hospital with a modern center that will house telehealth clinics, workforce training facilities, and business/education space. BASE grant funds supported construction costs for completing essential components of the Impact Center, including the parking lot, pavilion and canopy.

Grantee Information

The Green Living Foundation is a non-profit charitable foundation associated with the Neosho Memorial Regional Medical Center (NMRMC) that performs fundraising functions to benefit the hospital and local health interests.

Goals and Objectives

Goal: Strengthen Southeast Kansas' economy by creating and sustaining jobs through healthcare, education, and business partnerships.

Objective: Complete construction of the 11,000 sq. ft. Impact Center, along with the parking lot, pavilion, and canopy.

Budget Overview

- BASE amount: \$820,373.00
- Match amount: \$273,458.00
- Total project budget: \$1,093,831.00

Expense categories:

- Construction: \$980,356.24
- Landscaping and signage: \$113,474.76

Target Population

The target population for this project includes regional employers and community organizations that are seeking meeting and training space.

Sustainability

- Training programs will generate fee-based income that can be used for building operations and maintenance costs.
- Local employers are committed to using the facility for trainings and meetings which will also generate fee-based income for building operations and maintenance costs.

Outcomes

As the only multi-use facility of its kind in Southeast Kansas, it fills a regional gap and remains a long-term resource for healthcare, education, and business development.

Q1 - Q2 2025: Landscaping and signage
