
Project Summary

Barton County Community College utilized grant funds to build an Agriculture, Farm Machinery, and Transportation Technology Complex. This facility aims to bring together high-wage, high-demand programs such as Agriculture Business Management, Crop Protection, Beef Cattle Production, and Commercial Driver's License (CDL). Additionally, it will support the upcoming Case New Holland (CNH) Top Tech Industrial Service Training program, which prepares agricultural mechanics for the workforce.

The complex will feature: 3 classrooms, 3 specialized shop areas, storage for CDL vehicles and equipment, corrals, instructor offices, a loading dock, and a CDL testing area
