

Project Summary

Mid Star Lab's project under the DRAW grant focused on workforce development in the orthotics and prosthetics manufacturing sector across Kansas. Mid Star Lab enhanced their training programs for new hires and existing staff, including certified pedorthists, orthotic fitters, and technician training initiatives through education, cross-training, and process improvements.

Tonganoxie, Kansas



Target Population

The project focused on training staff and expanding services to better support underserved and highneed populations (e.g., diabetics, veterans, children, athletes, elderly individuals), especially those with mobility challenges or chronic conditions.

Goals and Objectives

Goal: To expand and strengthen the orthotics and prosthetics workforce in Kansas by providing specialized training and creating sustainable employment opportunities in the medical device manufacturing sector.

Objective: Upskill new and existing staff through vendor-led and in-house training programs.

Grantee Information

Mid Star Lab Inc is a family-owned and operated medical equipment manufacturer specializing in custom orthotics and orthopedic footwear. Founded in 1998, the company began as a wholesaler of orthotic inserts to podiatrists and foot care providers across the Midwest. Over time, it expanded to include direct patient services, diabetic and therapeutic shoes, and custom orthotic refurbishing.

Sustainability-

The project serves high-demand populations (e.g., diabetics, veterans, children), ensuring a steady need for services that can sustain operations through revenue and partnerships.

Outcomes -

By investing in education and cross-functional training, Mid Star Lab strengthened the local economy by creating skilled jobs and retaining talent in Kansas.

Five employees attended training to become Certified Pedorthists. One of the five has successfully completed the program, passed the certification exam, and is now actively seeing patients. The remaining four are continuing to make progress toward certification.
