
## Project Summary

Neosho utilized grant funds solely for the purpose of expanding the technical education center to provide various technical education programs, including healthcare, aerostructures, electrical technology, and industrial maintenance technology programs.

In 2018, Neosho County Community College(NCCC) purchased the Ross Lane facility in Chanute. Phase I of the building opened in August 2021, and Phase II in 2024. It housed six technical education programs with room for others in future phases.

Neosho County Community College (NCCC) is a well-rounded two-year institution dedicated to fulfilling its mission of meeting the educational needs of students. Their main campus is in Chanute, KS, offering the full campus experience, including housing, student activities, and athletics.
