Project Summary ————

The City of Elwood entered into a contact for the construction of a 30-bed 40,000-square-foot rehabilitation hospital, ClearSky Health. In order to operate the facility, the City had to extend its high-pressure water line and force main sewer line 1,500 feet. Both water and sewer improvements are available to the City's industrial park and other businesses in the area, including Elanco, a company that develops products and solutions for the animal health industry.

Goals and Objectives

- **Goal**: ClearSky Health will be operational by the end of 2022.
- Goal: Water and sewer improvements will be available to additional businesses in the area and the City's industrial park.
- **Objective:** Extend the high-pressure water line 3,800 feet and force main sewer line 1,500 feet.


Target Population -

Usage fees will provide a steady stream of revenue to cover the ongoing maintenance and operations costs of the water and sewer improvements.

Outcomes

- ClearSky Health will employ 75 full time employees at maturity, with an average salary of over \$65,000 per employee.
- The dollars spent in Doniphan County and Elwood by patients and their families is anticipated to create a ripple effect, spurring local investment and business opportunity.
- Water and sewer improvements will be available to Elanco, a key employer in the state that is expanding in Elwood.
 Expanding the operational capability at Elanco's Elwood manufacturing site is expected to create approximately 70 jobs in Doniphan County.
