

Project Summary

The TECHS project supported education and educational infrastructure to meet the healthcare needs of rural Kansas. TECHS implemented basic and advanced in-house training for current employees to maintain healthcare training, provided workforce training that includes initial courses for EMT's and AEMT's as potential future employees and healthcare initiatives in the Kansas communities of Holton, Osage City, Seneca and Troy.

Grantee Information

As one of the largest EMS providers in Kansas, TECHS provides EMS 911 services to multiple counties (Jackson, Nemaha, Osage and Doniphan). TECHS specializes in interfacility transfers from hospital to hospital across the majority of Kansas.

Goals and Objectives

Goal: Expand education and the educational infrastructure for current and prospective employees in the EMS field.

Objective: Provide basic/advanced in-house training to maintain healthcare initiatives.

Objective 2: Provide training including initial courses for EMT's and AEMT's to increase workforce in Kansas.

Budget Overview

- **Grant:** \$740,000.00
- **Match:** \$246,667.00
- **Total Budget:** \$986,667.00

Expense Categories:

- Training Salaries: \$162,444.91
- Educational Supplies: \$824,222.09

Target Population

The target population for this project was current employees needing training to meet continuation requirements and unemployed or underemployed residents of rural Kansas with an interest in entering the EMS field.

Sustainability

- TECHS has integrated the educational supplies needed for training into ongoing Troy, Osage City, Seneca and Holton operations.
- To continue offering low-cost trainings to community members additional funding will be explored.

Outcomes

- 315 Continuing Education Classes provided with 1,302 students served.
- 65 students enrolled in Initial Course Classes leading to State of Kansas EMS Certification
- Of the 65 individuals, 24 individuals either gained employment within TECHS or gained advancement to a higher level of care provider position.

Activities and Timeline

- Q3 2023:** Purchase of educational materials
- Q4 2024:** Advanced EMTs gained initial certification from State of Kansas
- Q2 2025:** Training fully implemented
