
Goals and Objectives

Target Population

the local economy of the small community, including residents and businesses impacted by the COVID-19 closures. By reopening the restaurant, the project supports economic revitalization through job creation, increased commerce for local vendors, and the restoration of a key community gathering spot that drives ongoing local spending.

Sustainability

The project is sustainable beyond the grant period because the business will generate revenue through regular food service operations, enabling the owner to cover payroll, maintenance, utilities, and future repairs above and beyond the one-time infrastructure repairs supported by this grant.

Outcomes

The restaurant is fully reopened and operating after completion of essential infrastructure improvements, including the roof, flooring, and parking lot.
