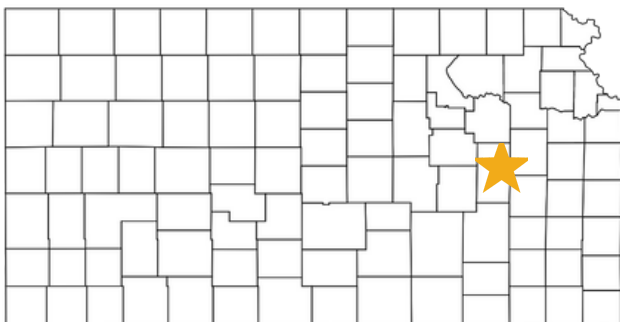

Project Summary

The City of Emporia supplies the water and sewer utilities that support economic activity at the Industrial Park III and IV. An increase in economic activity at the industrial park combined with watermain disruptions led to the need to improve utility service and reliability. Grant funds supported engineering and construction costs related to the utility upgrades. Funds also supported facility upgrades at the animal nourishment facility.

Grantee Information

Emporia, Kansas is strengthening its industrial base by investing in infrastructure improvements, including reliable utilities and transportation access, to attract new businesses and promote sustainable growth in the region.

Goals and Objectives

Goal: Improve electrical and water utility reliability and service capacity for tenants of the industrial park.

Objective: Upgrade waterlines servicing and powerlines servicing the park.

Goal: Increase production capacity at the animal nourishment facility.

Objective: Update infrastructure and equipment at the facility.

Budget Overview

- Budget: \$4,603,221.20

Expense categories:

- Engineering, Surveying, Easements: \$24,664.73
- Construction, materials and equipment: \$4,578,556.47

Target Population

The target population for this grant includes industrial tenants in Emporia's Industrial Park, with broader economic benefits to the Emporia community.

Sustainability

The long-term infrastructure investments supported by grant funds will strengthen the industrial park's appeal and ability to attract and retain tenants by reducing future utility disruptions and protecting business operations.

Outcomes

- Upgraded waterlines and circulation systems.
- Facility improvements that enhanced operational efficiency and production capacity at the animal nourishment facility.

powerline relocation

December 2022 - November 2023: animal
nourishment facility upgrades

April 2024 - August 2024: watermain
construction
